The Arboretum, first opened in 1852, was Nottingham's first public park. Home to a collection of 800+ trees, some of which were originally planted in the 19th century – you might struggle to give those ones a hug!

- 1 Waverley Street past war memorial and cemetery
- Enter Arboretum through the western gates next to Waverley Lodge.
- 3 Samuel Morley Bust
- 4 Circular Aviary only remaining Victorian aviary, once home to Cocky the Cockatoo who was reputed to have lived to 114!
- Pond
- 6 Flower gardens
- 7 Bandstand
- 8 Chinese Bell Tower monument commemoration two 19th Century military campaigns.
- Old Rose Garden
- 10 Time for a well-deserved cuppa at the Arboretum café.
- 11 Back along Waverley Street to the Premier Inn.
