- From York gate head straight up the middle of Inner Circle to Triton & Dryads Fountain
- 2 Regent's Park Open Air Theatre the oldest, professional and permanent outdoor theatre in Britain. It offers a range of events each year from May to September.
- 3 Grab an ice cream at the ice cream kiosk as you exit the inner circle
- 4 Bandstand
- Scoot alongside the boating lake, home to the Royal collection of waterfowl – how many different types of geese and ducks can you see splashing about?
- 6 Children's Boating Pond swap the scooter for a boat, open from end of July to October.
- 7 Hanover Gate Play Area
- 8 Hanover Bridges another good point for duck spotting
- 9 Carvings by Tom Harvey Girl with Jaguar & Girl and Fox
- 10 The Hub Café Time for a break?
- **11** St. John's Lodge One of the original Regent's Park residences, the villa is privately owned but the gardens are open to the public.
- 12 Queen Mary's Rose Garden a riot of colour in the flowering season.
- 13 Japanese Garden Island
- 14 Exit back onto York Bridge & York gate.
